DECLARATION OF DISCIPLINARY OR JUDICIAL DECISION

Under section 45.2 of the [Professional Code](#), a person must, in an application for a permit, inform the Ordre des ingénieurs du Québec (OIQ) that he or she has been the subject of a judicial or disciplinary decision. The Board of Directors of the OIQ may refuse to issue permits specifically in cases where the criminal offence committed was connected to the practice of the profession.
