- hold an engineer's permit in the meaning of the OIQ's regulations;
- be 62 years old or older (this age was determined using the Québec average as a reference, based on the data collected by the Québec Pension Plan);
- be retired, which means that they have ceased their professional engineering activities (they may still earn an income, just not from engineering);
- agree not to practice engineering in the meaning of the Engineers Act, even for free;

Members with retired member status are exempted from the continuing education requirements provided they comply with the eligibility requirements for this status.

Declaration

- **I have read section 60 of the Professional Code:**

"A professional shall elect domicile by informing the secretary of the order of which he is a member of the place where he principally practises his profession or, if he does not practise, his place of residence or principal place of employment, within 30 days after he begins to practise; the domicile thus elected shall constitute his professional domicile. He must also inform the secretary of all the other places where he practises his profession."

He must also advise the secretary of any change in this respect, within 30 days of the change.

"Every member of an order the constituting Act of which mentions, for election purposes or for any consultation of members, the place of residence or domicile rather than his professional domicile, must inform the secretary of his order of any change in his place of residence or domicile, as the case may be, within 30 days of such change."

- I understand that if I ever apply to be reinstated as an active member, I will have to pay the related fees, where applicable, and will be required once again to fulfill certain professional obligations, such as continuing education requirements if applicable.
