**INFORMATION**

**HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY RESTRICTIVE ENGINEERS'S PERMIT (TREP)**

Holders of a temporary restrictive engineer's permit (TREP) who registered for the roll between April 1, 2022 and March 31, 2023 paid a prorated amount for their first annual dues payment that varied according to the number of months remaining in the year ending March 31, 2023. For their second annual dues payment, they pay the full amount.

**RETIRED STATUS**

To be eligible for retired member status, members must meet the following conditions:

- hold an engineer's permit in the meaning of the OIQ's regulations;
  - be 62 years old or older;
  - be retired, which means that they have ceased or reduced their professional activities related or not to engineering, by ending their working life and working less than 30 hours per week or less than 1560 hours per year;
  - not practicing engineering;
  - not offering or rendering services in pre-purchase inspections.
- A member who no longer qualifies for retiree status must pay the full dues applicable.

**PERMANENTLY DISABLED MEMBERS**

To qualify for "permanently disabled" status, members must provide a proof of permanent disability issued by the Régie des rentes du Québec.

**CONTRIBUTION TO THE OFFICE DES PROFESSIONS DU QUÉBEC**

All members without exception must pay the mandatory contribution to the Office des professions du Québec (OPQ).

**GROUP PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE PLAN**

All OIQ members, except lifetime members (a status which has not been granted since 1993) and permanently disabled members must pay a premium for the group professional liability insurance plan.

<sup>3</sup> For holders of a half bachelor degree or partial equivalence, no annual renewal fee will be charged, until the bachelor degree or a total equivalence is obtained.

<sup>4</sup> Interview fees may vary in the event that external expertise would be required.

<sup>5</sup> For an ex-junior engineer or an ex-engineer-in-training who registers in the Professional Admission Program (PAP), the registration fee is \$ 460 in addition to a transfer fee of \$ 230, for a total of \$ 690.
