<p><b>1 PERMIT RENEWAL</b></p> <p>When applicable, the permit must be renewed on the anniversary date of issue, in addition to the annual fee. The number of renewals is limited to 3 for temporary permits (language requirements). Renewal is not applicable for temporary restrictive permits for holders of a French diploma approved by MRA.</p>
<p><b>2 SPECIAL AUTHORIZATION</b></p> <p>The annual fee does not apply to a special authorization; only the annual renewal on the anniversary date is payable. The holder of this special authorization is not registered on the Members Roll.</p>
INFORMATION
<p><b>HOLDER OF A RESTRICTIVE PERMIT, A TEMPORARY RESTRICTIVE ENGINEER'S PERMIT (TREP) OR A MEMBER OF ANOTHER CANADIAN ENGINEERING ASSOCIATION</b></p> <p>Holders of a restrictive permit, a temporary restrictive engineer's permit (TREP) or a member of another canadian engineering association, who registered for the roll between April 1, 2024 and March 31, 2025 paid a prorated amount for their first annual dues payment that varied according to the number of months remaining in the year ending March 31, 2025 (unless they have paid a prorated invoice before). For their second annual dues payment, they pay the full amount.</p>
<p><b>RETIRED STATUS</b></p> <p>To be eligible for retired member status, members must meet the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Be a licensed professional engineer;</li> <li>- Be at least 60 years old;</li> <li>- <b>Have ceased all professional engineering activities*</b> and have ceased or reduced all other professional activities;</li> <li>- Do not work more than 30 hours per week or 1,560 hours per year;</li> <li>- Do not offer or perform pre-purchase inspection services, even on a volunteer basis.</li> </ul> <p>A member who no longer qualifies for retiree status must pay the full dues applicable.</p> <p>* Professional engineering activities are those that constitute the practice of engineering as defined in section 1.1 of the Engineering Act. They include activities reserved for engineers, but also activities that are not reserved for engineers, such as engineering project management.</p>
<p><b>PERMANENTLY DISABLED MEMBERS</b></p> <p>To qualify for "permanently disabled" status, members must provide a proof of permanent disability issued by the Régie des rentes du Québec.</p>
<p><b>CONTRIBUTION TO THE OFFICE DES PROFESSIONS DU QUÉBEC</b></p> <p>All members without exception must pay the mandatory contribution to the Office des professions du Québec (OPQ).</p>
<p><b>GROUP PROFESSIONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE PLAN</b></p> <p>All IOQ members, except lifetime members (a status which has not been granted since 1993) and permanently disabled members must pay a premium for the group professional liability insurance plan.</p>

<sup>2</sup> CEP REGISTERED FOR LESS THAN 1 YEAR: at the time of the first renewal, the CEP must pay a prorata fee which will vary according to the number of months after the first anniversary of their registration in the PAP and April 1st of the following year.		
<sup>3</sup> For holders of a half bachelor degree or partial equivalence, registration fees are calculated according to the 0-6 months amount and no annual renewal fees will be charged, until the bachelor degree or a total equivalence is obtained.		
<sup>4</sup> Interview fees may vary in the event that external expertise would be required.		
<sup>5</sup> For an ex-junior engineer or an ex-engineer-in-training who registers in the Professional Admission Program (PAP), the registration fee is \$ 490 in addition to a transfer fee of \$ 245, for a total of \$ 735.		
<sup>6</sup> For a person with refugee status, a 50% discount applies on the admission fees and the admission examination fees. Certain conditions apply.
